## Notice of proposed changes to Bylaws and Rules of Order of Vicksburg Lodge 95

The Board of Trustees has approved changes to the Bylaws and Rules of Order of Vicksburg Lodge No. 95 which will be read on the floor of the Lodge during the 1st business meeting in October (10/10/18). The proposed changes are as follows:

**Under Article V:** Elective Officers and Duties - under duties of the Treasurer and of the Trustees increase the limit of unappropriated cash that requires notification by the Treasurer and above which may be demanded by the Trustees to \$15,000 dollars.

**Under Article X:** Fees and Dues - increase the annual Lodge dues to \$120.00 beginning Lodge year 2019/2020 (April 1, 2019).

These changes are necessary to reflect increases in per capita fees assessed by Grand Lodge and the Mississippi Elks Association and increases in our overall operating costs over the last several years. These changes must be confirmed by majority vote of the general membership and further approved by Grand Lodge before taking effect.
